Roadmap to the AMDC

2004: E-Government law defines unique identifier for individuals

2010: „Stammzahlenregisterbehörden-VO“

2011: First register-based census of Statistics Austria

2018: „Forschungsorganisationsgesetz FOG“

2018-2020: Intense lobbying by the scientific community (e.g. „Plattform Registerforschung“)

2020: AMDC in government program

2021: Preparation of amendments of the relevant legal acts. Federal Statistics Act und FOG (legal norms, stakeholder, data protection experts)

19.11.2021: Parliament concludes new legislation (Federal Statistics Act, FOG)

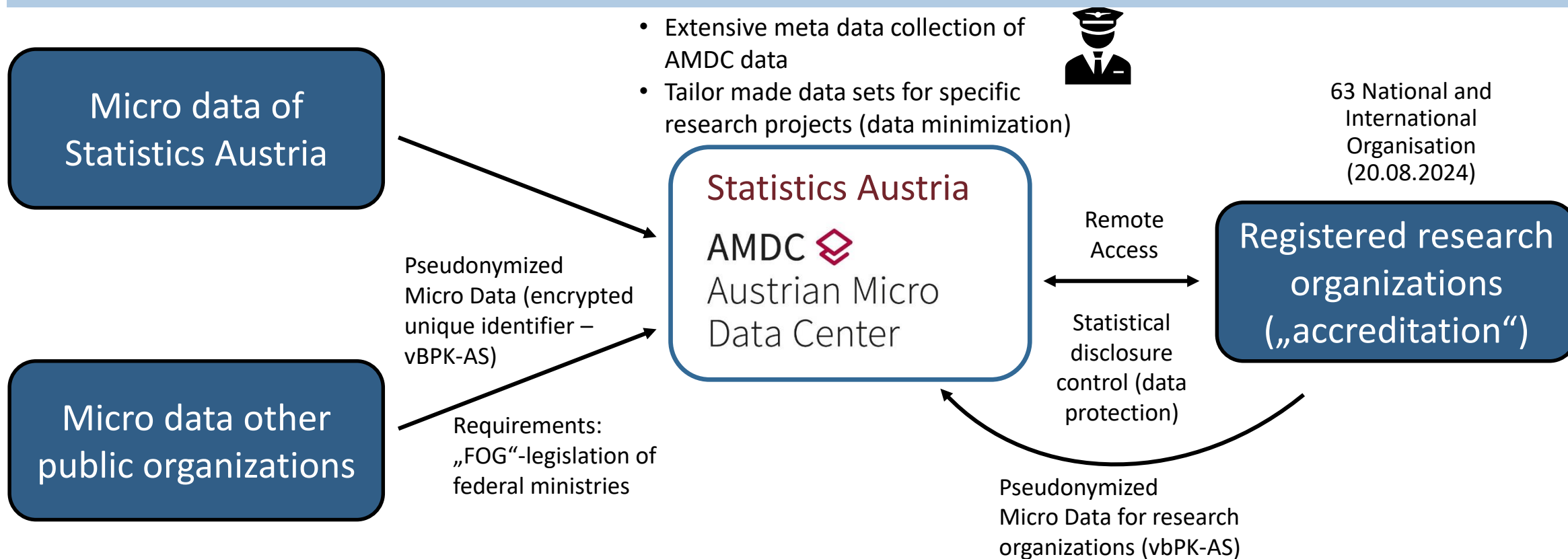

Remote-Access to micro data for research (One-Stop-Shop)

Start: 1. July 2022
Inspired by: CBS Centraal Bureau voor de Statistiek (NL), Statistics Denmark (DK) among others.
Data sets (20.08.2024): 116 data sets (e.g. Employment, Integrated income and payroll tax statistics, Micro Census)
Funding: 505.000 Euros p.a. by Federal Ministry of Research and Education (BMBWF) (fixed costs) **plus** revenues from research organizations (variable costs)

Access to micro data for evidence-based policy making

Formal requirements

1. Register the research organization at AMDC (accreditation)
2. Research proposal – choose micro data from our micro data catalogue:
<https://www.statistik.at/amdc-data/#/product>
3. Formal offer & contract
4. Research phase
5. Statistical disclosure control –SDC (review potential statistical disclosure of individuals & firms)

Options

- Ministries and other governmental bodies can exempt departments from formal instructions
- Ministries may contract accredited research organizations
 - No formal notice to Statistics Austria necessary

In both cases, the same rules are applied as for regular projects

- ✓ Research proposal necessary
- ✓ Data minimization
- ✓ No fast track procedure
- ✓ Statistical disclosure control
- ✓ Pricing
